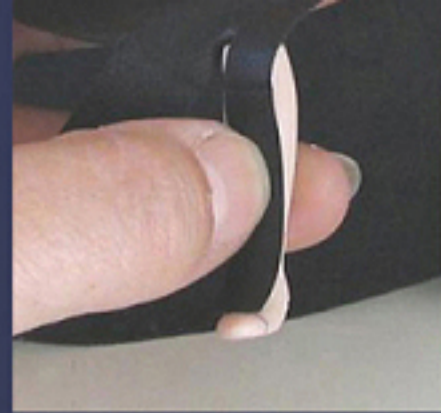


Make a line on the foot above the toes.



Take the piece of leather and cut off a strip of leather



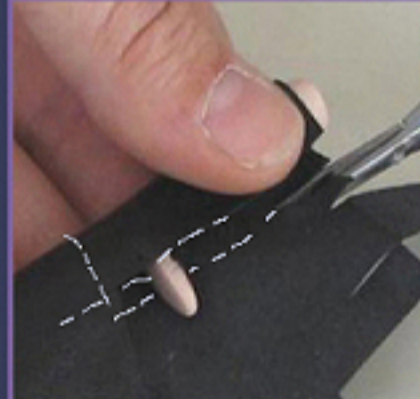
Put some glue on the front of the foot and spread it out a little, not a blob, please  
Glue the strip until the line



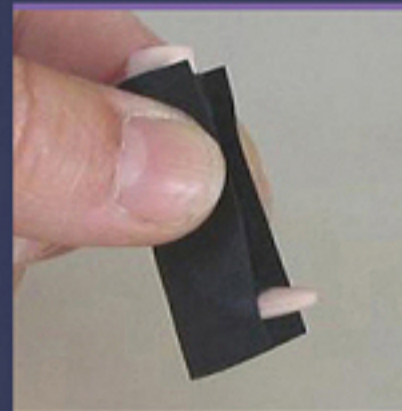
Press the strip of leather into the glue and let dry



Cut off a piece of leather, measure the size on the foot like shown



It should be wide enough to go around the foot  
Also, the leather should stop at the line



like this. Make it longer than the foot, we will glue the excess under the foot later



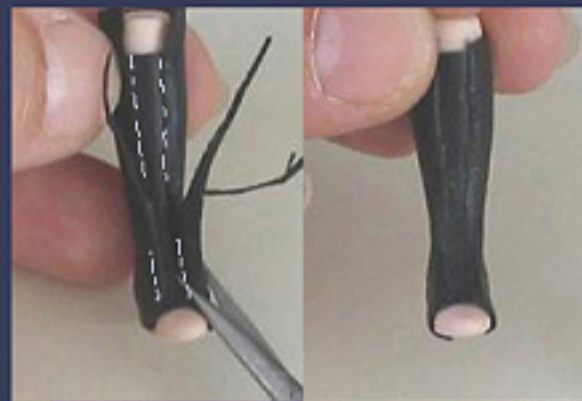
apply glue on the foot, only on the porcelain part, not on the leather



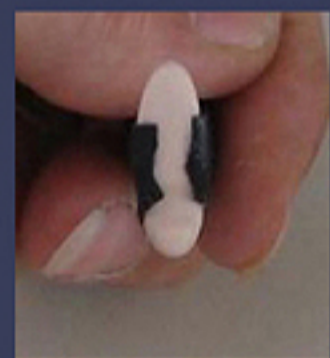
Press the piece in the glue and make sure it's neat around the foot.  
Cut out the heel part, a half circle



like this. You should end up with a blank heel



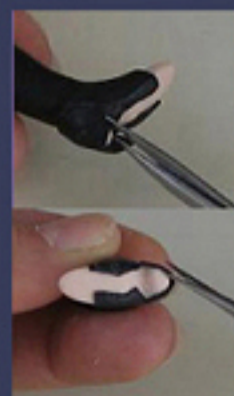
Cut the front edges of the boot, It's easier to make a mark with your fingernail or a blunt knife to determine where the cut should come. Start at the top cutting down, than at the bottom cutting up, the cuts meet in the bend of the ankle.



Glue the leather under the foot.



Cut a half circle and glue it on the heel part.  
Cut to fit, this way you have covered the heel of the boot on the back and sides.



After this is done, glue a strip of leather on the inside of the heel. The size depends on the height of the heel



Now cover the front of the boot with a piece of leather.  
Make sure you cover the existing leather just a little



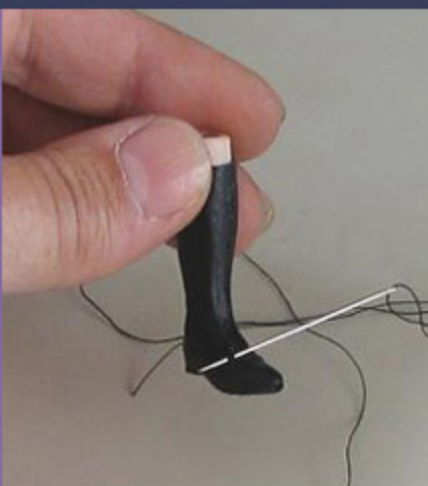
Cut the leather around the foot and glue on the sole



Cut a few pieces of leather and glue them UPSIDE DOWN (raw side up) under the sole, don't forget the heel! Let dry and cut to fit.



Now mark the top of the boot with a knife and Here I cut the front lower than the back side.



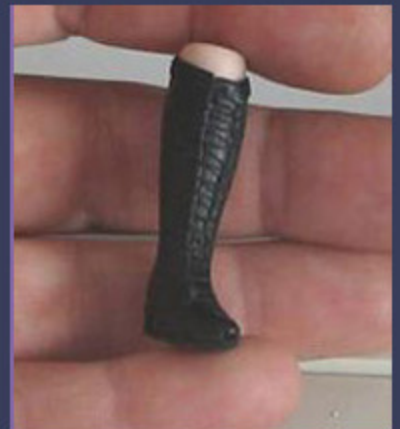
Now the laces...  
*Time for the magnifying glasses !!*  
Make a small knot at the end of the yarn.  
Start the first stitch from the inside out, with the knot tucked under the leather.



Stitch the straight yarn everytime op top, and the diagonal under like in



**IMPORTANT:**  
Make the stitches no too close to the edge of the leather, it might tear. If that happens, just glue the tear and glue the yarn in place.



Secure the yarn on top with a knot and some glue.  
I added a small strip of leather along the top of the boot as a



Make a bow,  
glue it on the boot.
